

## REACH-Regulation (EG) Nr. 1907/2006

The SRM Mikroelektronik GmbH (named SRM below) continuously monitors the progress of Regulation (EC) no. 1907/2006 (REACH) and supports its target respectively improvement relating to the protection of human's health and also the environment in its entirety - this by an improved and premature identification of the quality of chemical substances.

With this letter SRM confirms to the customers that they meet the relevant requirements concerning the REACH-Regulation. Existent respectively article-related information of distressing materials (substances of very high concern) will be passed on along the supply chain accordingly.

In context of the laws that define the handling of chemical substances, electrical components are classified as items. Substances that are enclosed in items, just have to be registered if they are released under normal or reasonably foreseeable usage. Substances that are enclosed in electrical components are not usually intended for such a purpose and therefore not have to be registered.

If products contain SVHC's exceeding the limit of 0.1%, the supply chain must be informed, even if the chemical substance is not released under normal or reasonably foreseeable conditions of usage. In this case SRM will pass on the information within the supply chain by an item-specific message on the commercial documents. SRM will always conduct the procedures in all conscience and also in conformity with Article 33 of the REACH Regulation.

All relevant information that are provided by SRM concerning REACH and SVHC's, are based on the data files of the product manufacturers and are provided without any warranty, guarantee and/or warranty of accuracy and/or completeness. This also embraces any statements, including those of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

SRM will follow any new developments and consequent obligations of the REACH Regulation and the attachment XIV (the list of candidates). In case of any modification concerning the commitment to the customers, SRM will update the course of action accordingly.

Naturally SRM will arrange all essential measures for ensuring the maximum performance and support to the customers.
